

CAMP ENROLLMENT is limited, and a minimum enrollment of 15 children must be met or camp will not be held that week at that site.

All Day Camps: \$50.00 per session RESIDENT \$100.00 per session - NON RESIDENT
Nessler Pre-camp: \$25.00 per session RESIDENT \$50.00 per session - NON RESIDENT

RESIDENT RATE

Pre-campers or students must be a Texas City resident or Texas City or La Marque ISD resident in order to be eligible to receive resident rate. For Texas City resident, you must provide proof of residency (ID, utility bill - electric, water bill, etc.).

For Texas City and La Marque ISD students, you must provide the participants most recent report card. To receive the resident rate you must provide the required information at the time of registration.

Registration is on a First Come - First Served Basis

Parents must sign camper in and out each day

Each session is 5 days (Monday-Friday, Rain or Shine)

Breakfast will be served from 7:30 am - 8:30 am daily.

Lunch and snacks will also be provided.

Camp Activities: Sports, arts & crafts, field trips and trips to parks.
