

Contractors

General Contractors

1. Must be registered with the City of Texas City
2. Must have a \$5000 License/Permit Bond or Liability Insurance
3. Must pull permits with the City for major jobs. May do minor repairs without a permit.
 - a. Roofers; minor repair is less than ¼ of roof.

Electrical Contractors

1. Must be licensed by the State of Texas as a Master Electrician and registered with the state as a contractor
2. Must have proof of liability insurance
3. Must be registered with the City.
4. Must display company name and license number of vehicles
5. Must have a Journeymen Electrician on the job

Heat and Air Conditioning Contractors (HVAC)

1. Must be registered with the State of Texas
2. Must be registered with the City.
3. Must have proof of liability insurance
4. Must have company name on vehicle
5. Must pull permits with the City for equipment replacement. May repair equipment without city permit.

Plumbing Contractors

1. Must be registered as a Master Plumber with the State of Texas and the City.
2. Must display company name and license number on vehicles.
3. Must pull permits with the City other than minor repairs
4. Must have a Journeymen Plumber on the job site.
