ELECTRICAL REQUIREMENTS FOR CONSTRUCTION IN TEXAS CITY

1. Minimum wire size #12. No BX or BXL.
2. No aluminum wiring for any reason.
3. Whips will not exceed 6 ft. for any reason. Ceilings will have 4 ½ ft. maximum in the return air.
4. Flex will be used for whips only. Flex cannot be looped from one fixture to another fixture.
5. All underground floors, walls and ceilings must be inspected before cover up. Ground wire must be in conduit.
6. MC cable may be used for 25' drops. No home runs.
7. All subcontractors must call for their own inspections with a ½ day notice.
8. All disconnects must be external within 6 feet of equipment.
9. In ceilings and walls, all conduit must have wiring pulled through before cover can be approved.
10. No EMT outside of any building.
11. Electrical contractor's vehicles working on job site must have contractor's name and license number.
12. All commercial and residential buildings must have one main outside disconnect on service and it must be labeled "Main disconnect".

PLEASE NOT ANYTHING ABOUT THIS PROJECT THAT MIGHT BE UNUSUAL OR THAT THE INSPECTIONS DEPARTMENT NEEDS TO BE AWARE OF. ONCE PERMIT IS ISSUED WORK MUST BEGIN WITHIN 6 MONTHS OR THE PERMIT IS INVALID.

It is understood by the undersigned that all work done under a permit issued pursuant to this application must be done in compliance with the ordinances of the City of Texas City, factory specifications and the above requirements.
